2. The quantities mentioned in the Tender Notice shall be deemed to be only approximate and will not in any manner whatsoever be binding on the OPGCL- Ib Thermal Power Station.
3. All tenders are to be submitted up to 13 hours on the opening date & they will be opened at 15 hours on the date specified. Representatives of the bidders those who choose to be present may attend the bid opening.
4. The tender shall remain open for acceptance for a period of 180 DAYS FROM THE DATE OF OPENING UNLESS OTHERWISE SPECIFIED. Tenders with a Validity of Less than 180 days are liable to be rejected/ or have lesser preference than those adhered the tender conditions.

10. 11. The delivery period quoted must be specific and realistic. 12.
