e-Reverse Auction (E-RA) shall be conducted for the works at Sl. No. 1, 2, 4 & 6 only. The Transaction
 Fees for e-Reverse Auction shall be deposited to the account of MSTC Limited directly.

The non-refundable **Transaction Fees towards e-Reverse Auction** as mentioned above shall be deposited by all Techno-Commercially qualified bidders directly to the account of MSTC before E-RA launch schedule. The date of conduct of E-RA shall be intimated in later stage to Techno Commercially qualified bidders via e-mail. Before participation in e-Reverse Auction, the bidder has to register in MSTC e-Procurement Portal well in advance and submit the E-RA fee amounting to the value intimated by M/s. MSTC Limited.

Cost of bid document (non-refundable) shall be paid by Demand Draft in favour of OPGC Ltd. drawn on State Bank of India (Code-9510) / Union Bank of India (Code-UBIN0806625) / Central Bank of India (Code-283899) payable at ITPS, Banharpali or ICICI Bank (Code-ICIC0003679) payable at Telenpali. Cost of bid document shall have to be submitted along with the bid and the DD towards the tender cost (separate from EMD) should be prepared on or before the last date of submission/receipt of tender, otherwise the bid shall be liable for rejection. Small scale industries/National Small-Scale Industries Corporation/ MSME firms are exempted from payment of Cost of bid document only if they are entitled for exemption of the offered service. Tenderers seeking exemption shall claim in advance along with the photocopy of Valid Registration Certificates at least two days before the due submission date. However, OPGC reserves the right to accept/reject the exemption request if the same is found unauthenticated or not relevant to the offered item. In case of any discrepancy found between tender document submitted by the agency and the master copy in our office, the latter should prevail. No claim on this account shall be entertained. Complete and signed sealed bids in hard copy form only shall be received at Contract Cell, ITPS. Bids shall be opened at Contract Cell, ITPS in the presence of the bidders or their authorized representatives, if present at the time of opening. If the last date of issue / receipt / opening happens to be a HOLIDAY, the tender will be issued/received/opened at the respective time on the next working day. The photocopies of all the supporting documents required for participating in the tender mentioned in NIT/Tender paper shall be submitted along with the bid; otherwise, the bid is liable for rejection. Bids without EMD will be rejected outright.

NB: Bidders having the requisite qualifying requirements as specified in the bid document shall only be considered for tender evaluation.

Bids received after stipulated date & time shall not be entertained. OPGC shall not take any liability on account of any postal/courier delay. OPGC reserves the right to accept / reject any or all tenders, seek

additional clarifications, split up the scope among eligible bidders or cancel the tender altogether without assigning any reasons thereof.

DETAILED INVITATION FOR EXPRESSION OF INTEREST (EOI) FOR SOURCING OF LIMESTONE MEANT FOR OPGC POWER STATIONS

#### 1.0 INTRODUCTION

OPGC Phase-I is a 2 x 210 MW sub-critical and OPGC Phase-II is a 2 x 660 MW supercritical power plant located at IB Thermal Power station, Banharpali, Jharsuguda, Odisha, India. The total capacity of station is 1740 MW.

While generating quality Power, OPGC has always been a fore runner in complying with stringent environmental norms. Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate change, in its gazette notification Dtd: 7<sup>th</sup> Dec. 2015, has amended the Environment (Protection) rules, 1986, which make it binding to the thermal power plants to reduce Sulphur Di Oxide (SO2) emission below the prescribed limit, depending upon the Unit size and year of installation of the Power plant.

For the purpose of capturing the SO2 from the flue gas before emission, Flue Gas Desulphurization (FGD) plants are required to be installed in the flue gas path. In compliance with the above said Gazette notification, *OPGC is under way of installation of FGD plant in 2 x 660 MW (OPGC-II) and in near future same is going to be installed for 2 x 210 MW (OPGC-I)*. As an input to FGD plants, Limestone ( $CaCO_3$ ) is required in huge quantities. Through this EOI, ITPS, OPGC, Banharpali, Jharsuguda, ODISHA desires to assess the domestic market for supply of Limestone of required Quality.

#### 2.0 INTENT OF THE EXPRESSION OF INTEREST (EOI)

IB thermal power station, OPGC, Banharpali, Jharsuguda, ODISHA invites "Expression of Interest (EOI)" for assessing the market response for shortlisting of Mine Owners/ Suppliers/ Agencies for further course of actions such as Long term tie up/ MOUs/ Tendering or any combination of these three options, for supply of 'Limestone' meant for FGD plants of OPGC coal fired thermal power plants/ stations, with minimum purity of 89% on CaCO3 basis. The Mine Owners/ Suppliers/ Agencies are required to submit details, along with physical and chemical characteristics of Limestone, as per the format enclosed at Schedule III.

The thermal power station wise requirement of limestone quantity and quality requirement of OPGC is as follows:

#### 1.0 SCOPE OF THE EXPRESSION OF INTEREST (EOI)

1.1 The scope of EOI is for supply of limestone to OPGC power stations for meeting the requirement of Flue Gas Desulphurization (FGD) Unit, with purity equal or greater than 90% on CaCO3 basis.

#### 2.0 TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THE EXPRESSION OF INTEREST (EOI)

- 2.1 IB Thermal power station, OPGC is likely to be commissioned with wet limestone based flue gas desulphurization (FGD) system in the year 2023-24.
- **2.2** The interested parties should be able to supply limestone as per required quantity and quality. The bidders should provide thermal power station wise data (size, quantity, cost etc.) of limestone being offered in the EOI.
- 2.3 Mine Owners/ Suppliers/ Agencies shall submit EOI. It may be noted that submission of EOI does not, in any way, constitute any kind of commitment on the part of OPGC.
- **2.4** The interested Mine Owners/ Suppliers/ Agencies shall make their own arrangement for transportation of limestone up to respective Power Plant of OPGC.
- **2.5** OPGC reserves the right to assess the capacity/ capability of the applicant and viability of proposal, based on verification of documents and if required, cross verification for establishment of the capable applicant(s).
- 2.6 OPGC reserves the right to accept or reject any or all applications, cancel/withdraw the EOI process without assigning any reason whatsoever, in case situation arises, and in such a case no applicant / intending applicant shall have any claim arising out of such action.
- 2.7 Interested Mine Owners/ Suppliers/ Agencies shall ensure proper care and constant vigil of transportation activities for any damages to any existing properties, which may result in Environmental hazards in any way, in case of award.
- 2.8 Interested Mine Owners/ Suppliers/ Agencies shall have to abide by the guidelines of the

- Expression of Interest (EOI) for Sourcing of Limestone for Flue Gas Desulphurization (FGD) Plants of OPGC Central Government/ State Government and ensure compliance, in case of award.
  - All applicable safety norms to be followed by the interested Mine Owners/ Suppliers/ Agencies while handling, transportation and unloading of limestone, in case of award.
- 2.9 All possible measures will have to be taken by the interested Mine Owners/ Suppliers/ Agencies, to avoid pollution while transporting, in case of award. No spillage of limestone will be permitted.
- 2.10 Interested Bidders may visit the site where FGD system will be installed. The owner shall provide all cooperation to the representative of the bidder in obtaining the required information during the visit to site. However, the cost associated to this EOI including preparation, site visit etc will be borne by the bidders only and no cost shall be reimbursed by OPGC of whatsoever nature.
